



FIND YOUR RING SIZE


MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger, the second best option is a ring worn on the right hand ring finger if measuring for engagement rings.
2. Place the ring over the nearest matching circle. The outside edge of the black circle should just touch the inside edge of the ring.
3. If you can see white paper between the inside edge of the ring and the outside edge of the black circle keep going up a size until you can't see the white inbetween anymore.

IS IT A SURPRISE?


Ask your significant other's friends or family if they know her finger size. Borrow one of her rings (from the correct finger) and use the ring measurements below to determine the correct ring size.

CONFIRM PRINTED SCALE



1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "None" in the print dialog box.

2. Measure the scale bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 1 inch or 30mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size and reprint before continuing.



Note: Tungsten rings cannot be measured by using this method.
